

## Comparatives and Superlatives: New Grammar Lesson for A1–A2

### 1. What Are They?

- **Comparative adjectives** are used when comparing two people, places, or things.  
(İki kişi, yer veya şeyi karşılaştırmak için kullanılır.) "2"
- **Superlative adjectives** are used to show the highest or lowest level of a quality in a group.  
(Bir grup içinde bir özelliğin en yüksek ya da en düşük seviyesini belirtir.) "3+"

### 2. How to Form Them (Yapı Kuralları)

#### A. Short Adjectives (1 heceli)

- **Comparative:** Add -er
- **Superlative:** Add -est

Example:

- This dog is **smaller** than that one.  
(Bu köpek, şu olandan daha küçüktür.)
- It is the **smallest** dog in the park.  
(Bu, parktaki en küçük köpektir.)

#### B. Long Adjectives (2 veya daha fazla hece)

- **Comparative:** Use more + adjective
- **Superlative:** Use the most + adjective

Example:

- That film is **more exciting** than this one.  
(O film, bu filmden daha heyecan verici.)
- It's the **most exciting** movie of the year.  
(Bu yılın en heyecan verici filmi.)

C. Irregular Adjectives (Düzensizler)

Adjective	Comparative	Superlative
good iyi	better daha iyi	the best en iyi
bad kötü	worse	the worst
far uzak	farther	the farthest

Example:

- She is a **better** singer than her sister.  
(Kız kardeşinden daha iyi bir şarkıcı.)
- He is the **best** player in the team.  
(Takımdaki en iyi oyuncu.)

◆ 3. When Do We Use Them? (Ne zaman kullanılır?)

- **Comparatives** are used for **two things**.  
(İki şey karşılaştırılırken kullanılır.)
- ▶ A train is **faster** than a bus.  
(Tren, otobüsten daha hızlıdır.)
- **Superlatives** are used to show **the most or least** in a group.  
(Bir grup içinde en fazlası veya en azı belirtilirken kullanılır.)
- ▶ She is the **most intelligent** student in the class.  
(Sınıftaki en zeki öğrenci o.)
