Reading Passage 12

The acclaim of many flat-faced dog breeds such as French bulldogs has risen steeply in recent years, despite regular but unconfirmed assertions that they are prone to many health issues including respiratory problems and sore eyes. However, a recent study led by the Royal Veterinary College's VetCompass programme, which examined the overall health of a random sample of 4,169 flat-faced dogs compared to 18,079 other dogs, has claimed that the flatfaced are more likely to suffer from an extensive range of health disorders. Out of the 30 common ailments found across both groups, flat-faced dogs have a higher risk of eight of them while other dogs had a higher risk of two of them. Flat-faced dogs were more than eight times more likely to suffer from the painful eye disease corneal ulceration, and three-and-a-half times more likely to suffer from heart murmurs. "Stop and think before buying a flatfaced dog." said Dr Dan O'Neill, lead author of the study. The outcomes support the general agreement by academics, British breed clubs, veterinary organizations and welfare bodies that urgent intervention is needed to breed dogs with less extreme body shapes, the researchers say.

Fransız buldokları gibi pek çok düz yüzlü köpek ırkının popülaritesi, solunum problemleri ve göz bozuklukları da dâhil olmak üzere birçok sağlık sorununa eğilimli olduklarına dair düzenli ancak doğrulanmamış iddialara rağmen, son yıllarda hızlı bir şekilde arttı. Ancak, 4.169 düz yüzlü köpeğin rastgele örneklerinin genel sağlığını 18.079 diğer köpeklerle kıyaslayarak inceleyen Kraliyet Veteriner VetCompass programı Koleji'nin tarafından yürütülen yakın tarihli bir araştırma, düz yüzlülerin çok sayıda hastalıktan mustarip olma olasılığının daha yüksek olduğunu ortaya koydu. Her iki grupta da bulunan 30 yaygın hastalıktan, düz yüzlü köpeklerde bunlardan sekizinin görülme riski daha yüksekken, diğer köpeklerde iki hastalık riski daha yüksek. Düz yüzlü köpeklerin ağrılı göz hastalığı kornea ülserinden mustarip olma olasılığı sekiz kat daha fazlaydı ve kalp üfürümlerinden mustarip olma olasılığı üç buçuk kat daha fazlaydı. Çalışmanın başyazarı Dr Dan O'Neill, "Düz suratlı bir köpek satın önce durun ve düşünün." Araştırmacılar, sonuçların akademisyenler, İngiliz cins köpek kulüpleri, veterinerlikler ve sosyal yardım kuruluşlarının daha az aşırı vücut şekline sahip köpekleri yetiştirmek için acil müdahaleye ihtiyaç duyulduğuna dair genel anlaşmayı desteklediğini söylüyorlar.
