**Eve geldiđimde seni aradım.** I called you when I got home.

**Derse başlamadan önce biraz tekrar yapacađım.**

Before we start the lesson, I will make some revision.

**Derse başlamadan önce biraz tekrar yaptım.**

Before we started the lesson, I made some revision.

If I have some free time, I will make some revision. (anlık plan)

If I have some free time, I make some revision. (genel)

If I were rich, I would / could travel the world. (unreal - günümüze dair senaryo)

If I had been rich 10 years ago, I would / could have travelled the world. (unreal -geçmişe dair senaryo)
