"Telephone," as a word, is, of course, related to "telegraph," an existing technology, which also transmitted signals. The word fragment "tele" is from a Greek word meaning "distance," and "phone," also a Greek word, means "sound." The telegraph, invented in 1837 by Samuel F. B. Morse (1791-1872), transmitted the "Morse Code," sounds (21) ---a wire. (22) ---- we could project sounds, little blips, over great distances, we could project the human voice. Even though he really wanted to keep several of the jobs, he would just blurt out what he was thinking before he had a chance to process the thought. Poorly thought-out decisions also relate to impulsivity. Rather than thinking a problem through, many ADHD people want an immediate solution and act without the necessary forethought. In a similar vein, impulsivity causes these people to have trouble going through the established channels at work.
