Healthcare professionals are **capable of treating wounds**, which can be detrimental **to a patient's health** if left untreated. It is **vital** (important, crucial, critical) **for healthcare professionals to provide** proper wound care to **prevent further harm**. **Simple and harmless wounds** can become infected and lead to (cause, bring about, result in, give rise to, trigger, induce, contribute to, stimulate) complications if (simple and harmless wounds are) not treated (V3: pasif kısaltma) **promptly**. **By providing gentle and effective wound care**, healthcare professionals can **help patients recover** (V0???: help + V0/to V0 alır) quickly, **allowing them to continue to flourish in their daily lives**.
