Explanation of "will" and "be going to" "- ecek / -acak"

#### Form:

# 1. Will

- o Positive: Subject + will + base verb (e.g., I will go).
- Negative: Subject + will not (won't) + base verb (e.g., I will not go).
- Question: Will + subject + base verb? (e.g., Will you go?)

### **Turkish Form:**

- o Olumlu: Özne + will + fiilin yalın hâli (Örn: Ben gideceğim).
- o Olumsuz: Özne + will not + fiilin yalın hâli (Örn: Ben gitmeyeceğim).
- o Soru: Will + özne + fiilin yalın hâli? (Örn: Gidecek misin?).

# 2. Be going to

- Positive: Subject + am/is/are + going to + base verb (e.g., I am going to go).
- Negative: Subject + am not/is not/are not + going to + base verb (e.g., I am not going to go).
- Question: Am/Is/Are + subject + going to + base verb? (e.g., Are you going to go?)

## **Turkish Form:**

- Olumlu: Özne + am/is/are + going to + fiilin yalın hâli (Örn: Ben gideceğim).
- Olumsuz: Özne + am not/is not/are not + going to + fiilin yalın hâli (Örn: Ben gitmeyeceğim).
- Soru: Am/Is/Are + özne + going to + fiilin yalın hâli? (Örn: Gidecek misin?).

## **Function and Meaning:**

## 1. Will:

- Used for instant decisions or promises made at the moment of speaking.
  - Example: "I will help you." (Şimdi karar verildi: Sana yardım edeceğim.)
- Expresses future facts or certainty.
  - Example: "It will rain tomorrow." (Kesinlik: Yarın yağmur yağacak.)
- Offers, promises, or threats.
  - Example: "I will call you tonight." (Söz: Bu gece seni arayacağım.)

# 2. Be going to:

- Used for plans or intentions made before the time of speaking.
  - Example: "I am going to study tonight." (Plan: Bu gece ders calışacağım.)
- Used to express predictions based on evidence.
  - Example: "Look at the clouds! It is going to rain." (Kanıta dayalı tahmin: Şuna bak! Yağmur yağacak.)

# **Time Expressions:**

Will: Tomorrow, next week/month/year someday in the future, later. / Turkish: Yarın, gelecek hafta/ay/yıl, bir gün, gelecekte, sonra.

Be going to: Tonight, later today, tomorrow, in two days, soon.

Turkish: Bu gece, bugün daha sonra, yarın, iki gün içinde, yakında.

Turkish: Meşgul olduğu için partiye gelmeyecek. = she will not come / she won't come

5. I (call) you later tonight. (Use "will")

Answer: I will call you later tonight.

Turkish: Bu gece seni sonra arayacağım.
