2. As contradictory health advice appears in tabloid newspapers on an almost daily basis, people argue whether sunlight is beneficial or harmful to human health.

talk about

3. Even now, when we talk about the possibility of a big idea changing science, we say "we need another Einstein".
4. You might have noticed that many diet companies no longer use the word 'diet'; they talk about 'lifestyle' instead.

discuss

5. Surveys show that 30% of people have never discussed organ donation with their friends and relatives.
6. The possibility of lowering the age of partial responsibility to 12 is being discussed in many regions of Arizona because of the immensely growing number of crimes committed by 14-year-old individuals.

debate

7. Print culture allowed knowledge to be disseminated more quickly and be debated in salons and coffee houses.
